### Multistate Examinations

The National Conference of Bar Examiners, [www.ncbex.org](http://www.ncbex.org), is a service organization providing standardized examinations to nearly every jurisdiction in the United States. We suggest you visit this site for NCBE test dates and a detailed overview of each NCBE test. Current tests which NCBE provides are:

**1. The Multistate Bar Examination (MBE)** – a six-hour, two-hundred question multiple-choice examination covering contracts, torts, constitutional law, criminal law, evidence, and real property. You should contact the jurisdiction where admission is being sought to ascertain whether the MBE is part of the jurisdiction's examination.

**2. The Multistate Essay Examination (MEE)** – a collection of 30-minute essay questions and is administered by participating jurisdictions. The MEE has traditionally offered seven questions per examination, with most jurisdictions selecting six questions from the seven. You should contact the jurisdiction where admission is being sought to ascertain whether the MEE is part of the jurisdiction's examination.

**3. The Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (MPRE)** – a sixty-question, two-hour and five-minute, multiple-choice examination administered three times each year. The MPRE is required for admission to the bars of all but three US jurisdictions. Passing scores, which are established by each jurisdiction, currently vary between 75 and 86. You are advised to contact the jurisdictions directly for the most current information regarding passing scores, rules, and policies.

**4. The Multistate Performance Test (MPT)** – three 90-minute skills questions covering legal analysis, fact analysis, problem solving, resolution of ethical dilemmas, organization and management of a lawyering task, and communication. You should contact the jurisdiction where admission is being sought to ascertain dates of administration and whether one or more MPTs are part of the jurisdiction's examination.
